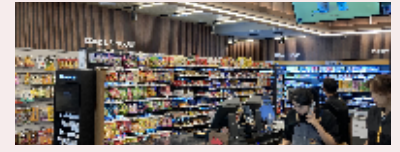
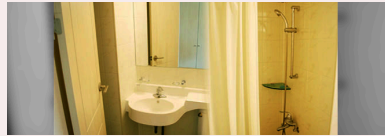

ON-CAMPUS HOUSING


